



A CONVERSATION WITH JIM TRAFICANT

James A. Traficant Jr., who served nearly two decades in Congress and seven years in prison for corruption, is running as an independent candidate in his northeast Ohio home turf.

The seat is currently held by Democrat Tim Ryan, who once worked for Traficant and beat Traficant when the incumbent ran for re-election from prison.

The 68-year-old Traficant was elected to nine terms in Congress as a Democrat from Youngstown before serving time for racketeering, bribery, obstruction of justice and tax evasion. He left federal prison in September. His conviction does not bar him from running for Congress.

Traficant told the AP that he believes he can win in the Democratic stronghold despite the fact that he has no money or campaign staff.
